

3	Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Anthony Economus against the		
4	City and County of San Francisco for \$275,000; the lawsuit was filed on May 2, 2019, in		
5	San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-19-575669; entitled Anthony Economus v.
