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3	Ordinance authorizing partial settlement of the lawsuit filed by Ruth Patricia Del		
4	Castillo against the City and County of San Francisco for \$150,000; the lawsuit was		
5	filed on August 20, 2015, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492;		
6	entitled <u>David Alfaro, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco;</u> the lawsuit involves		
7	inverse condemnation arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms in		
8	December of 2014; this settlement relates only to the diminution of real property value		
9	claims of plaintiff Ruth Patricia Del Castillo, and does not include claims for property		
10	loss or for attorney's fees, costs and interest.		
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12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
13	Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby		
14	authorizes the City Attorney to settle in part, and only as to plaintiff Ruth Patricia Del Castillo,		
15	the action entitled David Alfaro, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco		
16	Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492 by the payment of \$150,000 to plaintiff Ruth		
17	Patricia Del Castillo. The lawsuit involves inverse condemnation arising out of flooding		
18	damage during major rainstorms in December of 2014.		
19	Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on		
20	August 20, 2015. This is an action brought by owners or occupants of several dozen		
21	properties located in San Francisco against defendant City and County of San Francisco.		
22	Section 3. This is a partial settlement of the action. It resolves the diminution of real property		
23	value claims of plaintiff Ruth Patricia Del Castillo. The parties have previously, separately		
24	settled the personal and real property damage claims of plaintiff Ruth Patricia Del Castillo in		
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1	this action, and will subsequently and separately address all claims for statutory attorney's
2	fees relating to this action.
