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3	Ordinance authorizing partial settlement of the lawsuit filed by Sally Seid against the			
4	City and County of San Francisco for \$207,000; the lawsuit was filed on			
5	August 20, 2015, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492; entitled			
6	David Alfaro, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco; the lawsuit involves inverse			
7	condemnation arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms in December			
8	of 2014; this settlement relates only to the diminution of real property value claims of			
9	plaintiff Sally Seid, and does not include claims for property loss or for attorney's fees,			
10	costs and interest.			
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12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:			
13	Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby			
14	authorizes the City Attorney to settle in part, and only as to plaintiff Sally Seid, the action			
15	entitled David Alfaro, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco Superior			
16	Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492 by the payment of \$207,000 to plaintiff Sally Seid. The			
17	lawsuit involves inverse condemnation arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms			
18	in December of 2014.			
19	Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on			
20	August 20, 2015. This is an action brought by owners or occupants of several dozen			
21	properties located in San Francisco against defendant City and County of San Francisco.			
22	Section 3. This is a partial settlement of the action. It resolves the diminution of real			
23	property value claims of plaintiff Sally Seid. The parties have previously, separately settled			
24	the personal and real property damage claims of plaintiff Sally Seid in this action, and will			
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1	subsequently and	separately address all	claims for statutory	attorney's fees relating to	o this
2	action.
