Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled <u>Lina Lu et al. v. City and County of San Francisco</u>, et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CPF-19-516659 by the payment of \$49,00 in attorneys' fees and the adoption of certain changes in the San Francisco Police Department's procedures for producing domestic violence incident reports under California Family Code § 6228. The lawsuit involves a claim that the Police Department

was not producing incident reports in a timely way and was redacting the reports in a way that

the law did not permit.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on May 6, 2019, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiffs Lina Lu, Alexandra Anderson, and Stella Osborne, and Defendants City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco Police Department, and William Scott in his official capacity as Chief of Police.
