Emergency Solutions Grant A&E

- As part of the Federal CARES Act, San Francisco has received a second grant amount of \$43,605,003 under the Emergency Solutions Grant program
- Funds are required to be spent on COVID impacts on homeless people
- HSH is proposing the grant support the continuation of essential services and operations for Shelter in Place (SIP) Hotels
- These funds will be important to ensure full implementation of the Homeless Recovery Plan



Emergency Solutions Grant A&E

- A&E also modifies the expenditure schedule previously approved by the Board for first ESG CARES allocation of \$5.5M to better align with Shelter in Place Hotels and Emergency Shelter funding needs

MOHCD COVID-19 Initiatives

- Operate Give2SF – Housing Stabilization Program which provides direct financial assistance. Currently deploying \$3 million to support 1,000 of the most vulnerable applicants
- COVID-19 HELP (Homeowner Emergency Loan Program)
- Digital Equity - Coordinating with DT, expanded program to provide free high-speed Internet to 1,500 additional households
- Implementation of Mayor Breed’s housing-related Emergency Orders
- Coordinate COVID-19 testing & resource support to HOPE SF/RAD communities (partnering with HRC & SFHA)
- Debt relief for affordable housing owners experiencing COVID impacts
