

I am unable to give public comment at today's hearing. So I'm submitting it to your Clerk, John Carroll. I chair my neighborhood association and am a leader of <u>RescueS</u>F - a grassroots coalition of community orgs and neighbors lobbying for more effective and faster action to address street homelessness. I support the City's Settlement of the Hastings lawsuit. I urge you to vote FOR the settlement. I've read the settlement document. It is fair and involved key stakeholders living in the Tenderloin community.

Moreover, much of the plan has already been implemented. At last report, the City has met the first item of the settlement -- to relocate 70% of those camping in the Tenderloin to safe off-street shelter. And the settlement requires getting the remaining tent campers into safe shelter. This process has been extensively covered by the press and is viewed as successful. So please do not disrupt this plan. Thank you.
