Pursuant to Board Rule 4.20, as Chair of the Government Audit and Oversight Committee, I have deemed the following matters are of an urgent nature and request that each be considered by the full Board on Tuesday, September 22, 2020, as Committee Reports:

## File No. 200919 [Supporting University of San Francisco Workers United During COVID-19]

Resolution supporting USF Workers United, a broad coalition of workers and faculty members at the University of San Francisco, drastically affected by furloughs, cuts in healthcare and employment benefits, and lack of safety protocols during COVID-19.

## File No. 200955 [Urging the Association of Bay Area Governments in the Regional Housing Needs Allocation Process to Focus on Unmet Needs for Affordable Housing]

Resolution urging the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) in its upcoming Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA) Process to focus on San Francisco's unmet needs for housing affordable to low- and moderate-income residents, counteract the displacement of low- and moderate-income communities of color in core urban cities like San Francisco and Oakland, prioritize increases to the region's above-moderate RHNA allocation in high resource and high opportunity jurisdictions, and limit increases in above-moderate RHNA allocations to Bay Area cities with concentrations of Sensitive Communities.
