Conditions for Type 21 - Off Sale General

- 1. Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. each day of the week.
- 2. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 200 ml is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Beer, malt beverages, and wine coolers in containers of 16 oz. or less cannot be sold by single containers, but must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities.
- 4. Petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on ABC-253.
