WHEREAS, The State of California will hold a general election on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of voting on candidates for federal and state offices, as well as proposed state ballot measures to be submitted to the voters; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will hold a municipal election on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of voting on candidates for local office and proposed local ballot measures to be submitted to the voters; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has called a special election to be held in the City and County of San Francisco on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of voting on a proposed general obligation bond measure, and consolidated the special municipal bond measure election with the State of California General Election scheduled for the same date; and

WHEREAS, The Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) District will hold a district election on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of voting on candidates for the BART Board of Directors,

2	canvassed by the Director of Elections as provided in the California Elections Code.
