[Contract Amendment - Insight Public Sector Inc. - Technology Marketplace - Not to Exceed 1 \$28,000,000] 2 Resolution authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to enter into a First 3 Amendment for Technology Marketplace purchases between the City and County of 4 San Francisco and Insight Public Sector Inc., a Tier 1 contractor of the Technology 5 6 Marketplace 2.0, to increase the contract amount by \$8,000,000 for a total contract 7 amount not to exceed \$28,000,000 with no change to the three-year term to expire on December 31, 2021, with two one-year options to extend, at the sole and absolute 8 discretion of the City. 9 10 11 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires the Board of Supervisors to approve by Resolution contracts estimated to cost the City \$10,000,000 or more; and 12 WHEREAS. The Office of Contract Administration wishes to procure information 13 technology products and services on an as-needed basis through the Technology 14 Marketplace; and 15 16 WHEREAS. This Agreement was competitively procured as required by Administrative Code, Chapter 21.1, through Request for Proposals #99400 "Tiers 1 and 2 of the Technology 17 Marketplace 2.0" a Request for Proposal ("RFP") issued on June 20, 2018, in which City 18 selected Contractor as a qualified proposer pursuant to the RFP; and 19 WHEREAS, The Local Business Entity ("LBE") subcontracting participation 20 21 requirement for the contract is 15% for services, with the exception that the requirement will be 10% for training services; and 22 WHEREAS, Contractor has been awarded approximately \$1,068,175 in services 23 and/or training since the contract start date, of which \$621,985 (58.23%) has been awarded to 24 LBEs; and 25

1	WHEREAS, Contractor represents and warrants that it is qualified to perform the
2	services required by the City as set forth under the contract; and
3	WHEREAS, Contractor represents and warrants that it is qualified to perform the

5	WHEREAS, The City's Civil Service Commission approved the contract, File No.
6	44114-17/18 on July 10, 2018; and
7	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved the original contract on January 15,
8	2019, by Resolution No. 009-19; and
9	WHEREAS, The Office of Contract Administration proposes to amend this contract in
10	an amount not to exceed \$28,000,000 to meet City business needs; and
11	WHEREAS, The contract amendment referenced above is substantially in the form
12	attached and are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 200938, which
13	is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be
14	it
15	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Purchaser and Director of
16	the Office of Contract Administration to execute the First Amendment to the contract to
17	increase the contract amount by \$8,000,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed
18	\$28,000,000, with no change to the three-year term to expire on December 31, 2021, with two
19	one-year options to extend, at the sole and absolute discretion of the City; and, be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the First Amendment being fully
21	executed by all parties, the Purchaser and Director of the Office of Contract Administration
22	shall provide the final contract to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
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
