12	Section 1. Article XIII of Chapter 10 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by	
13	adding Section 10.100-334, to read as follows:

15	SEC. 10.100-334. SOCIAL HOUSING PROGRAM FUND.	
16	(a) Establishment of Fund. The Social Housing Program Fund is established as a category	
17	four fund to receive any monies appropriated or donated for the purpose of providing funds for the	
18	acquisition, creation, operation, development, construction, or rehabilitation of Social Housing	
19	Developments as defined in subection (e).	
20	(b) Use of Fund. The Social Housing Program Fund shall be used exclusively for the purpose	
21	of providing funds for Social Housing Developments including, but not limited to, the acquisition of	
22	land and/or improvements, preservation, development, rehabilitation, construction, operation, loans,	
23	grants, and other eligible uses determined by the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community	
24	Development ("MOHCD"), and as included in any Social Housing Program Fund regulations.

1	(c) Administration of Fund. MOHCD shall administer the Social Housing Program Fund,
2	and in that capacity may expend funds for eligible uses and enter into loan or grant agreements under
3	terms as determined in the Social Housing Program Fund regulations.
4	(d) <b>Reporting.</b> MOHCD shall submit a report annually by September 1 to the Board of
5	Supervisors and the Mayor on the use of the Social Program Housing Fund during the preceding fiscal
6	year, which may include, but need not be limited to, the amounts approved for disbursement, the
7	number of sites acquired and type (incuding improved or vacant), the scope of rehabilitation work for
8	improved sites, the number of units developed or assisted by the Social Program Housing Fund, and
9	overall program implementation goals and priorities for the next fiscal year.
10	(e) Social Housing Developments. Social Housing Developments are housing developments
11	that meet the following two criteria: (1) the City retains an ownership interest in the land,
12	improvements, or both, and (2) the Social Housing Development serves income qualified households
13	with an average of not more than 80% of area median income, as determined and published by
14	MOHCD and affordable to such households applicable to a unit. Social Housing Developments shall
15	include, but not be limited to, community land trusts, limited equity cooperative housing, and municipal

19	(f) Fund Regulations. The Director of MOHCD, or the Director's designee, is authorized to
20	develop program rules or regulations regarding use of monies in the Social Housing Program Fund to
21	best achieve the purposes of the Fund.

23	Section 2. Background.
24	(a) It is the intent of the Board of Supervisors to appropriate to the Social Housing
25	Program Fund revenues from the General Fund generated from any real property transfer tax

1 increase passed by the San Francisco electorate in the November 3, 2020 election, although 2 nothing in this Section 2 or in Section 10.100-334 of the Administrative Code requires the City 3 to appropriate any revenues from such real property transfer tax increase for this purpose. (b) It is the intent of the Board of Supervisors to enact an ordinance establishing an 4 5 advisory committee to provide policy advice and recommendations regarding the Social 6 Housing Program Fund, and to monitor implementation of the Social Housing Program Fund, 7 although nothing in this Section 2 or in Section 10.100-334 of the Administrative Code 8 requires the City to enact such an ordinance. 9 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after 10 enactment. ### LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Social Housing Program Fund]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to establish a Social Program Housing Fund for the acquisition, creation, and operation of affordable Social Housing Developments.

#### Existing Law

Section 10.100-1 of Article XIII of Chapter 10 of the San Francisco Administrative Code, Administration of Special Funds, establishes fund categories to assist with the financial management of special funds or accounts as such fund accounts are authorized by the City. The City has established special funds or accounts under Section 10.100-1.

#### Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance, if adopted, would amend Article XIII of Chapter 10 of the Administrative Code by adding Section 10.100-334 which amendment would result in the establishment of the Social Program Housing Fund for the acquistion, creation and operation of affordable Social Housing Developments.

#### **Background Information**

The Social Housing Program Fund would be established as a category four fund to receive any monies appropriated or donated for the purpose of providing funds for the acquisition, creation, operation, development, construction, or rehabilitation of Social Housing Developments which are defined as housing developments that meet the following two criteria: (1) the City retains an ownership interest in the land, improvements, or both, and (2) the Social Housing Development serves income qualified households with an average of not more than 80% of area median income, as determined and published by the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development (MOHCD) and affordable to such households applicable to a unit. Social Housing Developments shall include, but not be limited to, community land trusts, limited equity cooperative housing, and municipal housing. MOHCD would establish minimum requirements for Social Housing Developments, including but not limited to, enforceable income and affordability restrictions through a recorded restriction or ground lease from MOHCD.

MOHCD would be required to submit a report annually by September 1 to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor on the use of the Social Program Housing Fund during the preceding fiscal year, which may include, but need not be limited to, the amounts approved for disbursement, the number of sites acquired and type (incuding improved or vacant), the scope of rehabilitation work for improved sites, the number of units developed or assisted by the Social Program Housing Fund, and overall program implementation goals and priorities for the next fiscal year.

The Director of MOHCD, or the Director's designee, would be authorized to develop program rules or regulations regarding use of monies in the Social Housing Program Fund to best achieve the purposes of the Fund.
