18	during major rainstorms in December of 2014.	
19	Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on	
20	August 20, 2015. This is an action brought by owners or occupants of several dozen	
21	properties located in San Francisco against defendant City and County of San Francisco.	
22	Section 3. This is a partial settlement of the action. It resolves the diminution of real	
23	property value claims of plaintiffs John and Maria Naniola. The parties have previously,	
24	separately settled the personal and real property damage claims of plaintiffs John and Maria	
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1	Naniola in this action (see Board Ordinance No. 111-18), and will subsequently and
2	separately address all claims for statutory attorney's fees relating to this action.
