12	identify as a survivor of violence or crime, for a two-year term ending June 1, 2022.
13	Michael Brown, seat 2, succeeding Angela Coleman, term expired, must be a former
14	inmate in the San Francisco County Jail, a California Department of Corrections and
15	Rehabilitation facility, and/or a United States Bureau of Prison facility; and also have expertise
16	in providing services to individuals exiting the criminal justice system, for a two-year term
17	ending June 1, 2022.
18	Oscar Salinas, seat 3, succeeding Victoria Westbrook, term expired, must be a former
19	inmate in the San Francisco County Jail, a California Department of Corrections and
20	Rehabilitation facility, and/or a United States Bureau of Prison facility; and also must have
21	been released from custody within three years of his/her appointment, for a two-year term
22	ending June 1, 2022.
23	Jabari Jackson, seat 4, succeeding Theodore Tolliver, term expired, must be a former
24	inmate in the San Francisco County Jail, a California Department of Corrections and
25	Rehabilitation facility, and/or a United States Bureau of Prison facility; and also must have

1	served multiple terms of incarceration, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending
2	June 1, 2022.
