To whom it may concern,

I, Danielle Kuzinich, am writing on behalf of San Francisco Wine Society - a wine bar located at 408 Merchant Street, San Francisco, CA 94111. I applied for a type 42 on sale beer and wine license through the San Francisco ABC office on September 18th, 2020. This license will replace the type 42 license that was previously issued here and had been in operation without ABC violation since October of 2011.

I posted required signage at the premises on September 30th, 2020, which will remain up for the required 30-day posting period. Required mailers were sent out on October 14th, 2020 to all residences within a 500' radius.

San Francisco Wine Society is an elegant wine bar with an emphasis on service and hospitality. Society to us is about inclusion, community, diversity and participation. We value the importance of human interactions, so there will be no TVs or screens. With table service of approximately 71 seated guests, our wine bar will operate from 2:00 PM to 10:00 PM Sunday – Monday and will be open from 2:00 PM to 12:00 AM Tuesday – Saturday as demand requires and for special engagements. The wine bar will undergo some slight cosmetic improvements but will operate much like it has since 2011 with a private dining room, patio seating, outdoor bocce ball court, and bar seating.

Our menu will consist of sharable plates encouraging a relaxed dining experience in an upscale environment. We will source quality, seasonal ingredients from local farms and artisan producers. We will feature a different wine region each month allowing us to guide our guests on a journey of time and place. Through education and empowerment, we will create a culture that is attractive to locals and tourists.

For our community, we will be donating 100% of the proceeds of a specialized wine by the glass to sponsor lunch and music programs for Bay Area elementary students. We hope to donate upwards of \$80,000 to those programs by the end of 2021.

We expect that approximately 55% of revenue to come from wine, 35% from food, and 10% from non-alcohol beverage sales.

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We are committed to continue providing quality food and beverages for locals and tourists alike in a safe and relaxed environment. San Francisco Wine Society will employ 8-10 new hires providing jobs, tax revenues and charitable donations to the local community.

I have spent the last fifteen years managing restaurants in San Francisco and spent the last nine years managing The Hidden Vine until it closed in January. I now have the opportunity to continue managing and operating the same location as its owner. With so many iconic restaurants and bars in San Francisco not reopening due to the hardships of COVID, I would love the chance to revive one of San Francisco most revered wine bars.

Thank you for your consideration of our application to provide alcohol sales to the guests of San Francisco Wine Society.


