AMENDMENT No. 2 TO THE 2007-2011 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO

SAN FRANCISCO FIRE FIGHTERS UNION LOCAL 798, IAFF, AFL-CIO UNIT 2

The parties hereby amend the Memorandum of Understanding as follows:

SECTION 9. SALARY

9.1 Employees shall receive the following base wage increases:

July 1, 2010 - 4%	<u> January 8, 2011 - 2%</u>



THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO CONCERNING

THE CITY'S 2008-2009 AND 2009-2010 BUDGETS



In recognition on the City's severe budget crisis and the parties' joint interest in minimizing reductions in City services and the number of layoffs, on behalf of its members the San Francisco Fire Fighters Union requests that and authorizes the City to hold 2% of the 4% general wage increase scheduled to be effective on July 1, 2009 for the purpose of allowing the San Francisco Fire Fighters Union's membership to vote on a tentative agreement to defer said general wage increase and to extend the MOU through FY 2011-12. In the event that the San Francisco Fire Fighters Union's membership approves the tentative agreement described above by August 1, 2009, the resulting MOU amendment will be filed with the Board of Supervisors and will become effective retroactively when approved by the Board and signed by the Mayor. In the event that the membership does not ratify the tentative agreement, the 2% of the 4% from the July 1, 2009 wage increase being held will be retroactively implemented and the parties shall return to the status quo.
