1	[Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - United States Department of Transportation -		
2	California Office of Traffic Safety - Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program - \$100,000]		
3	Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and		
4	expend a grant in the amount of \$100,000 from the United States Department of		
5	Transportation through the California Office of Traffic Safety for participation in a		
6	program, entitled "Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program," for the period of October 1,		
7	2020, through September 30, 2021.		
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9	WHEREAS, The United States Department of Transportation (DOT), through the		
10	California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) as a pass-through entity, has agreed to fund the		
11	Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$100,000 for participation in a program,		
12	entitled "Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program," for the period of October 1, 2020, to		
13	September 30, 2021; and		
14	WHEREAS, The funds will be used to devise best practices to reduce the number of		
15	persons killed and injured in crashes involving pedestrians and bicyclists; and		
16	WHEREAS, The practices may include classroom education, bicycle rodeos,		
17	community events, presentations, and workshops; and		
18	WHEREAS, Coordinated efforts, such as Safe Routes to Schools initiatives, Vision		
19	Zero campaigns, and working with community based organizations, will be encouraged to		
20	prevent fatalities and injuries of vulnerable non-motorized road users; and		
21	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and		
22	WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received		
23	the full award letter on September 28, 2020, for a project start date of October 1, 2020; and		
24	WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,		
25	therefore, be it		

1	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in		
2	the grant budget; and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and		
4	expend a grant in the amount of \$100,000 from the DOT through the OTS; and, be it		
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and		
6	expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it		
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
8	Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Grant Agreement being fully		
10	executed by all parties, the Director of Health shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board o		
11	Supervisors for inclusion in the official file.
