- Court ordered as a condition of probation supervision Least restrictive alternative






EM Clients: Age Group






EM Clients: Gender

PROGRAM RULES

- Notify probation staff of any arrest, citation or police contact within 24 hours
- Notify probation staff of any change in address or contact information
- Submit to search, as appropriate
- Refrain from possessing any weapons or illegal drugs
- Refrain from tampering with or removing the EM device
- Keep the device charged and report any problems with the equipment
- Attend all counseling and programming directed by the Court and/or probation staff
