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4	Resolution urging Management Agreements and all other relevant governing
5	documents pertaining to Community Benefit Districts (CBDs), Business Improvement
6	Districts (BIDs) and Green Benefit Districts (GBDs) to prohibit the acceptance of
7	anonymous gifts, to make it the administrative policy of the City and County of San
8	Francisco to request reporting of the acceptance of non-assessment private
9	contributions or gifts on an annual basis, and to prohibit the acquisition of surveillance
10	technology without a public hearing and approval by the City and County of San
11	Francisco.
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13	WHEREAS, Community Benefit Districts, Business Improvement Districts and Green
14	Benefit Districts strive to improve the overall quality of life in targeted residential, commercial
15	and mixed-use districts and neighborhoods through partnerships with the City and local
16	communities; and
17	WHEREAS, The aforementioned entities are governed by Management Plans or
18	Management Agreements that are routinely amended or updated to meet evolving conditions
19	and needs of District stakeholders, and which are subject to approval by the City and County
20	of San Francisco; and
21	WHEREAS, Management Plans, Management Agreements and other relevant
22	governing documents may be amended administratively without amending Articles 15 or 15A
23	of the San Francisco Business and Tax Regulations Code, or any other authorizing body of
24	state or local law; and

1 WHEREAS, Community Benefit Districts, Business Improvement Districts and Green 2 Benefit Districts are alter egos of the City and County of San Francisco derivative of State and 3 local law, and their conduct therefore reflects upon the integrity of their authorizing public agencies; now, therefore be it 4 5 RESOLVED, That Community Benefit Districts, Business Improvement Districts and 6 Green Benefit Districts should be held to the same good government standards, best 7 contracting practices, and public health and safety laws set forth in the Charter and Municipal 8 Code of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it 9 FURTHER RESOLVED, It is in the best interest of the public, stakeholders and beneficiaries of Community Benefit Districts, Business Improvement Districts and Green 10 Benefit Districts that the Management Agreements and all relevant governing documents be 11 12 amended to prohibit their acceptance of anonymous gifts and to require annual reporting to 13 the City and County of San Francisco of the acceptance of all non-assessment private 14 contributions and gifts; and, be it 15 FURTHER RESOLVED, It is in the best interest of the public, stakeholders and beneficiaries of Community Benefit Districts, Business Improvement Districts and Green 16 17 Benefit Districts that the Management Agreements and all relevant governing documents be 18 amended to require any new acquisition of surveillance technology be subject to a public hearing and approval process by the Board of Supervisors, either by Resolution or by 19 20 Ordinance; and, be it 21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the City and 22 County of San Francisco shall transmit this Resolution to the governing entities of each 23 Community Benefit District, Business Improvement District and Green Benefit District of the

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City and County of San Francisco.
