- Assumed 50% Expenditure Recovery from FEMA
- Remaining 50% Expenditures Covered from GF

- COVID Command Center (CCC) Staffing
  - Temporary Positions (7) Hired for the CCC
  - SF Housing Authority Laborers (10)
- Moscone South Operations include Facility Costs
- SFSD Staffing for Securing PPE Warehouse
- DEM Operating Costs to Support COVID Activities
- Joint Information Center (JIC) Costs
  - Temporary Positions (4) Hired for the JIC
  - Outreach and Public Messaging Campaigns

- BLA Recommends Keeping \$1.20M on Reserve
