

On October 2, 2020, Building Permit Application No. 202010025735 was filed to change the use of the ground floor commercial space at 1098 Howard from Limited Restaurant to Specialty Grocery, in order to allow the business (dba Tony Baloney's) to obtain a Type 21 ABC License. A Type 21 ABC License permits an establishment to sell beer, wine and distilled spirits for consumption off the premises where sold. Under the Planning Code, this license type is permitted in conjunction with a Specialty Grocery use, but not a Limited Restaurant.

As such, the Planning Department recommends approval of the requested PCN letter, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The sponsor shall COMPLETE BPA 202010025735 by obtaining and issued permit and completing all inspections.
- 2. The site shall maintain shelves and product sales of a Specialty Grocer and shall not revert to a Limited Restaurant use after license approval. Specifically, the site shall maintain at least 85% of the gross floor area for sale of "specialty food products such as baked goods, pasta, cheese, confections, coffee, meat, seafood, produce, artisanal goods, and other specialty food products, and may also offer additional food and non-food commodities related or complementary to the specialty food products."
- 3. No more than 15% of the gross floor area shall be devoted to the sale of alcohol products.
- 4. The business shall comply with the operating conditions of Planning Code Section 202.2(a)(1).
