Resolution urging the Office of Workforce and Economic Development (OWED) and
Public Works to adopt a policy that Community Benefit Districts, Business
Improvement Districts and Green Benefit Districts (hereafter "Districts") shall disclose
all private contributions on an annual basis, cease accepting anonymous
contributions, and disclose their use of surveillance technology to the Board of
Supervisors at a public hearing.
WHEREAS, The City establishes Community Benefit Districts, Business Improvement
Districts and Green Benefit Districts (hereafter, "Districts") to fund supplemental services in
residential, commercial and mixed-use districts and neighborhoods through partnerships with
local communities, with administrative oversight from the Office of Workforce and Economic
Development and Public Works; and
WHEREAS, Districts are required to prepare annual reports, and submit them to the
Board of Supervisors for approval following a public hearing, that disclose information about
the District budget, the activities to be provided in the District for the coming fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, The City has an interest in ensuring that the Districts remain accountable

and transparent to the public, and it is in the best interest of the public that the City should

set forth in the Charter and Municipal Code of the City and County of San Francisco; and

hold the Districts to the same good government standards and public health and safety laws

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other information as required by law; and

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WHEREAS, There is a particular interest in transparency, accountability, and good government with respect to Districts' acceptance of private contributions and with respect to Districts' use of surveillance technology; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, The Office of Workforce and Economic Development and Public Works should each adopt a policy that all current and future Community Benefit Districts, Business Improvement Districts and Green Benefit Districts shall disclose to the City as part of the annual report hearing and approval process all private contributions that they have received, and that Districts shall not accept any anonymous contributions; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Office of Workforce and Economic Development and Public Works should each adopt a policy that all current and future Community Benefit Districts, Business Improvement Districts and Green Benefit Districts shall not use any surveillance technology unless the purpose of that use, as well as any conditions or restrictions on the proposed use of surveillance technology, have been disclosed in advance of any such use to the Board of Supervisors through the annual report hearing and approval process; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco shall transmit this Resolution to the Office of Workforce and Economic Development and Public Works, who shall then transmit copies to the governing entities of each Community Benefit District, Business Improvement District and Green Benefit District in the City.
