

3	Resolution commending and honoring Supervisor Sandra Lee Fewer for her dedicated
4	service to San Francisco and her venerable service as a Member of the San Francisco
5	Board of Supervisors.

7	WHEREAS, Supervisor Sandra Lee Fewer has proudly served District 1 and the City
8	and County of San Francisco for four years as a member of the San Francisco Board of
9	Supervisors; and
10	WHEREAS, Supervisor Sandra Lee Fewer has served the community and the City of
11	San Francisco as a mother, the Director of Parent Organizing and Education Policy at
12	Coleman Advocates for Children and Youth, a 12-term Parent Teach Association (PTA)
13	President, a 2-term School Board Commissioner, the Member of the Board of Supervisors
14	representing District 1, the Chair of the Local Agency Formation Commission, and the Chair of
15	the Budget and Finance Committee since January of 2017; and
16	WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has championed the cause of building and preserving
17	affordable housing by authoring legislation to give affordable housing non-profits the first right
18	to purchase apartment buildings, creating a fund explicitly for affordable housing production
19	and preservation in the City, and authoring a ballot measure to create affordable housing for
20	teachers and families all across the City; and
21	WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has fought to create a Westside Affordable Housing
22	Development Organization; and
23	WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has brought her signature style of consensus-oriented
24	leadership by prioritizing community feedback and participation; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has taken the lead in responding to current
 emergencies, like the citywide COVID-19 response and in preparing the Richmond District for
 future emergencies like tsunamis, earthquakes and major fires; and
 WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has been a pioneer for the causes of equity and
 transparency in the City and County of San Francisco by creating the Office of Racial Equity,

task force and business plan to establish a public bank and requiring that all departments and
offices hold public meetings before submitting budget proposals; and

creating the first immigrant legal defense unit in the Public Defender's Office, advocating for a

9 WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer led the Richmond District in fostering strong community 10 bonds around the values of mutual care and support by creating the One Richmond Program, 11 bringing the Autumn Moon Festival to the neighborhood, and connecting the community with 12 essential resources by way of organizing the annual Community Health Fairs; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has prioritized traffic safety and the implementation of
 the Vision Zero Program, and launched a grassroots #fewerpotholes campaign that led to the
 repair of hundreds of potholes in the Richmond neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has authored legislation protecting small businesses in
the City and addressing vacant storefronts, prioritized the preservation of cultural and
historical businesses through the Legacy Business Registry, and nominated a dozen
businesses in the Richmond for inclusion to the Legacy Business Registry; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has broken ground on criminal justice reform by collaborating with the Sheriff's Office and community organizations to close the outdated and unsafe County Jail #4 and by leading on the People Over Profit Ordinance that makes phone calls free in jails; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Fewer has brought mobile homeless services to the Richmond,
 authored legislation that will create a comprehensive housing inventory in San Francisco, and
