

1 [Accept and Expend Gift - Retroactive - The Joan Kelley-Ryder Bequest - Support of Resident
2 Care Programs - \$200,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
4 **expend a monetary gift in the amount of \$200,000 from the Joan Kelley-Ryder Trust to**
5 **support resident care programs for the residents at Laguna Honda Hospital and**
6 **Rehabilitation Center, for the period of December 1, 2020, through December 30, 2030.**

8 WHEREAS, Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center (Laguna Honda) is part
9 of the San Francisco Health Network operated by the Department of Public Health (DPH), and
10 is a safety net and community hospital, with a mission to provide a welcoming, therapeutic
11 and healing environment that promotes the individual's health and well-being; and

12 WHEREAS, The trustee for the Joan Kelley-Ryder Trust (Kelley-Ryder) has notified
13 Laguna Honda their intention to distribute a cash bequest totaling \$200,000 to the Laguna
14 Honda Hospital Gift Fund (LHHGF); and

15 WHEREAS, The Laguna Honda Hospital Gift Fund is used to benefit the residents at
16 Laguna Honda, including providing comfort and support for all Laguna Honda residents; and

17 WHEREAS, The Health Commission Resolution No. 20-12 recommends that the Board
18 of Supervisors authorize DPH to accept and expend a gift of cash of up to \$200,000 donated
19 by Kelley-Ryder to the LHHGF to support resident care programs; and

20 WHEREAS, Expenditures of the proceeds would be consistent with the purpose of the
21 LHHGF to provide support to, and enhance the well-being of the residents of Laguna Honda;
22 now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the gift and retroactively
24 authorizes DPH to accept and expend a gift of cash in the value of up to \$200,000 donated by

1 Kelley-Ryder to Laguna Honda for the support of resident care programs for the residents at
2 Laguna Honda; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the proceeds of the gift by Kelley-Ryder will be accepted
4 and expended consistent with Administrative Code Sections governing the acceptance of gifts
5 to the City and County of San Francisco, including Administrative Code, Section 10.100-201;
6 and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors extends its gratitude to Kelley-
8 Ryder for the generous gift to the City and County of San Francisco in support of Laguna
9 Honda.
