Bloomingdale's was founded in 1861, and the San Francisco location serves as its West Coast flagship location. Bloomingdale's prides itself on providing a complete and enjoyable shopping experience for our customers along with superior customer service. This department store contains an extensive home section which includes a dedicated wine and bar accessories section, as well as an extensive line of drinkware and other fine serveware. The addition of this license will provide a convenience for our customers by providing a one-stop shopping location to purchase their wine or spirits in conjunction with their accessory items. In the busy and congested downtown area, it is a convenience for our customers to be able to purchase all of their items in one location, and not have to go to a second or even third location, saving both travel time and parking issues. By offering these additional products, we can provide more of the experience our clients expect.

While it is understood that the census-tract is over-concentrated, there are no other similar locations in the vicinity offering the same full and high-end shopping opportunities as the applied-for premises, making this a unique location for shoppers. In addition, while the number of licenses is deemed over-concentrated for the residential population, this does not account for the numerous people that come to this highly popular area, nearby to Union Square, for work, entertainment, and tourism (estimated at over 26 million in 2019), thereby creating an increased need for services, including those such as offered by the applicant.

This company has a long history as a reputable operator, and will implement policies, procedures and a training program to prevent any alcohol-related incidents. The issuance of the applied-for license will not create or add to law enforcement problems in the area.
