13	MTA to plan for these intersections and to include their plans in the Environmental Impact
14	Report pending before the Superior Court; and
15	WHEREAS, The Bicycle Plan Update of 2004 under consideration by the
16	Superior Court did not include several dangerous intersections; now, therefore, be it
17	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors calls upon the MTA Board of Directors to
18	direct MTA staff to commence study on improving bicycle safety through reengineering the
19	intersections of (1) Market Street, 10th, Polk and Oak and (2) Division and 13th,
20	South Van Ness and Howard; and, be it
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors calls upon the MTA Board of
22	Directors to direct MTA staff to commence study on improving bicycle safety along Division,
23	13th and Duboce between Folsom and Valencia through appropriate, innovative bicycle
24	network treatments; and, be it
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1	FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors calls upon the MTA Board of
2	Directors to direct MTA staff to produce plans for consideration by the Board of Supervisors or
3	the MTA Board for implementation by June, 2010.
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
