8	WHEREAS Under Blonning Code, Section 1004.1, the Board of Supervisors may by

11	WHEREAS, The Trocadero Clubhouse in Sigmund Stern Grove is the earliest building
12	in the Parkside District and one of the last surviving nineteenth-century structures in
13	southwestern San Francisco; and
14	WHEREAS, Constructed circa 1892, the Trocadero is a distinctive example of Stick-
15	Eastlake architectural style with high integrity; and
16	WHEREAS, The Trocadero was built by George Green Jr. as the "Trocadero Inn," a
	roadhouse and resort; and
17	WHEREAS, The Trocadero building survives as the city's last intact example of a
18	nineteenth century roadhouse that once lined the roads of western and southern San
19	Francisco; and
20	WHEREAS, The Trocadero was the site of the arrest of Abe Ruef, a key figure in the
21	government corruption trials after the 1906 earthquake and fire; and
22	WHEREAS, The Trocadero was the site of early twentieth century women's and girls'
23	clubs, women's job training classes, and suffragette meetings; and

1	WHEREAS, In 1931, the Trocadero was preserved by the City of San Francisco with a
2	gift from Rosalie Stern to serve as a site of recreation; and
3	WHEREAS, The Trocadero's renovation was overseen by renowned master-architect
4	Bernard Maybeck in 1931-1932; and
5	WHEREAS, The Trocadero has hosted hundreds of community meetings, weddings,
6	birthday parties, and other celebrations for more than seventy years as a public site; and
7	WHEREAS, The Trocadero is integral to the landscaping and plan of Stern Grove as a
8	public park where an annual series of free music concerts has been held since 1932; and
9	WHEREAS, The Trocadero is recognized by the City of San Francisco as locally
10	significant for the purposes of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on its
11	inclusion in Here Today: San Francisco's Architectural Heritage by Roger Olmsted and W. H.
12	Watkins (1968); now, therefore, be it
13	RESOLVED, That the Board hereby initiates landmark designation of the Trocadero
14	Clubhouse in Sigmund Stern Recreation Grove built in 1892 and located at 2750-19th
15	Avenue; and, be it
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board requests that the Planning Department
17	prepare a Landmark Designation Report to submit to the Historic Preservation Commission
18	for its consideration of the special historical, architectural, and aesthetic interest and value of
19	the Clubhouse; and, be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board requests that the Historic Preservation
21	Commission consider whether the Clubhouse warrants landmark designation and submit its
22	recommendation to the Board according to Article 10 of the Planning Code; and, be it

24	Preservation Commission to respond to landmark designation initiations from the Board within
25	90 days, but that the Board of Supervisors may, by resolution, extend the time within which

the Historic Preservation Commission is to render its decision; therefore, in order to allow the Planning Department more time to complete its review of this landmark designation, this Resolution shall also serve as a 90-day extension of that deadline, for a total of 180 days to respond starting from the transmittal date.
