I'm a resident and homeowner in Bayview for over 11 years now. I am applying for community seat 6 on the Urban Forestry Council. I believe I am the best candidate because I am an extremely active community organizer who is dedicated to greening our neighborhood and city.

I have the support of my community and the urban forestry community, because I have worked so hard to support my neighbors and to make our neighborhood someplace we can be proud of.

To be a positive force for change, I contacted the Friends of the Urban Forest and became the Bayview—Hunters Point volunteer neighborhood organizer for tree planting. 

Ordinance 21-01 (Admin. Code Chapter 5 Article XXIII). Ordinance 171-03 (repealed Admin. Code Chapter 5, Article XXIII). Ordinance No. 210-08 restructured the Council.

Board Qualifications:

The Urban Forestry Council composition and administration was restructured by Ordinance No. 210-08 as follows:

Council members will represent the full range of urban forest stakeholders including city agencies, non-profit organizations, tree management organizations, and community members. The Urban Forestry Council shall be comprised of 11 total members, 7 of whom will be appointed by the Board of Supervisors as follows:

One representative from an educational organization involved with tree management (University of California Cooperative Extension, etc.);

Two members certified by a professional tree management organization (International Society of Arboriculture, American Society of Consulting Arborists, or American Society of Landscape Architects);

Two members of non-profit organizations involved in urban forestry or other environmentallyrelated issues; and

Two members from the community.

The Mayor shall appoint two voting members as follows:

One member from the tree care industry; and one member at large.

The following departments shall have voting members:

Director of the Department of Public Works or designee; Director of the Planning Department or designee.

The Council shall have advisory members comprised of representatives from the following departments: Recreation and Park Department and Public Utilities Commission.

In addition, the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency, and the Golden Gate National Recreation Area are invited to send representatives to sit as advisory members of the Council. The Body that appoints Council members also may appoint at-large members to serve any unfilled Council positions. Members shall serve for a term of two-years. Members can serve successive terms if reappointed by the body originally appointing the Council member. The Council shall meet at least once each month and establish its own operating procedures, which at a minimum, shall meet the public notice, meeting, voting, agenda and other procedural requirements set forth in local law. Subcommittees shall be created to adequately address other special areas of concern on an as needed basis. The Department of the Environment, with adequate funding to assist the Council in carrying out its mission, shall provide professional and administrative staff to the Council.

As newly constituted by Ordinance No. 210-08, at 12:00 noon on the 30th day following the effective date of this ordinance (Nov. 18, 2008), the tenures of the persons currently holding seats on the Urban Forestry Council shall expire. The eleven persons appointed as members of the Urban Forestry Council as provided in this Section shall assume office at 12:00 noon on November 18, 2008; provided that if any appointing authority has not made a new appointment by such date, the sitting member shall continue to serve for sixty days. The two-year terms of those members appointed pursuant to subsections (a)(I), (a)(2), and (a)(3) shall commence on that date.
