9	California Department of Pesticide Regulation (CDPR) to fund a project entitled "Pesticide

11	WHEREAS, Through this grant, the CDPR has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of		
12	\$2,880 for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011; and,		
13	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDPR requires the City to		
14	enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the		
15	Board of Supervisors in File No; which is hereby declared to be a part of		
16	this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
17	WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH		
18	for one existing position, Industrial Hygienist (Job Class #6138) at 0.04 FTE, for the period of		
19	July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011; and,		
20	WHEREAS, The budget does not include a provision for indirect costs because indirect		
21	costs are not allowed by the funding agency; now therefore, be it		
22	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the		
23	amount of \$2,880 from the CDPR; and, be it		
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
25	indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it		

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2	FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and		
3	expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and		
4	be it		
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
6	funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when		
7	the agreement expires; and, be it		
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
9	agreement on behalf of the City.
