Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. In order to promote Small Business Week, and permit sidewalk sales of merchandise, the fee for temporary street space occupancy set forth in Public Works Code Section 724.1, subsection (b), shall be waived on Saturday, May 15, 2010, between 7 am and 9 pm, in the following geographic areas of the City:
