

1 [Authorizing the Sheriff's Department to contract with Global Tel*Link (GTL) for Inmate
Telephone Services]

2 **Resolution approving a contract for operating the Sheriff's Inmate Telephone Services,**
3 **between GLOBAL TEL*LINK, and the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and**
4 **through the Sheriff's Department.**

6 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Sheriff's Department requested bids for Inmate
7 Telephone Services; and,

8 WHEREAS, A five member panel evaluated and scored the written proposals in
9 accordance with the City approved selection criteria; and,

10 WHEREAS, The Human Rights Commission determined DBE/LBE subcontracting
11 goals do not apply; and,

12 WHEREAS, The five member panel determined Global Tel*Link is the best responsive
13 and responsible proposer; and,

14 WHEREAS, Charter Section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations", Subsection (a)
15 requires Board of Supervisors' approval of any contract which, when entered into, has
16 anticipated revenue of one million dollars or more; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has an Inmate Welfare Fund, as provided for in
18 California Penal Code Section 5000-5030.1; and,

19 WHEREAS, Global Tel*Link shall pay to the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund a
20 percentage commission of 60% of gross revenue sales; and,

21 WHEREAS, Global Tel*Link shall pay to the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund an
22 additional \$100,000 payable thirty days from contract execution, and \$100,000 annually thirty
23 days after the contract anniversary date; and,

1 WHEREAS, The proposed contract agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
2 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution
3 as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Inmate Telephone
5 Services Agreement by and between Global Tel*Link, and the City and County of San
6 Francisco, acting by and through its Sheriff's Department, for a three-year term beginning
7 April 1, 2010, with two one-year options exercisable by the Sheriff's Department.
