[Supporting Senate Bill 330 Regarding University of California]

## Resolution supporting Senate Bill 330 for increased transparency and accountability in auxiliary organizations and foundations in the University of California and California State University systems.

WHEREAS, The University of California and California State University systems have been able to evade the requirements of the California Public Records Act (CPRA) by shifting university responsibilities to foundations and auxiliary organizations; and

WHEREAS, The University of California and California State University systems are required to comply with the California Public Records Act (CPRA), in order to ensure transparency and accountability; and

WHEREAS, Instances of misconduct and misuse of funds have been discovered at CSUs within foundations and auxiliary organizations; and

WHEREAS, Local community college auxiliaries are already subject to the CPRA, which led to discovery and accountability in instances of abuse and waste; and

WHEREAS, The California State Senate has recently passed Senate Bill 330 (SB330) to include UC and CSU foundations and auxiliary organizations under CPRA requirements; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of San Francisco strongly endorses and supports the transparency goals of SB330; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of San Francisco encourages amendments to SB330 to ensure accountability and transparency while still protecting anonymous donations.
