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

Dear Board of Supervisors,

My name is Patrick Flanagan. I have been a resident of The Rose Hotel since Aug 15th 2007. I have worked as a Community Organizer for Community Housing Partnership since August 2008. I have also worked as Artistic Director for Living Miracle Productions since October of 2004. I have produced, directed and performed in many live shows in the Tenderloin and throughout the city of San Francisco. I have been a resident of San Francisco since June of 1991. I moved here from New York where I graduated from Binghamton University with a B. A. in Sociology.

I believe that I would be an ideal candidate for the SRO Task Force. For the last 8 months I have been instrumental in establishing a Tenant Council for The Rose Hotel. I served as Tennant Council President for the first three months during the initial start up phase. I am happy to say that the Rose Tennant Council is still operational, meeting on a monthly basis, and those meetings are well attended.

As a member of the SRO Task Force my main concerns will be addressing violence in the SRO's. Especially violence perpetrated by SRO Tenants upon other SRO Tenants. As a direct result of my efforts, The Rose Hotel is now conducting anger management courses and quickly evicting tenants who cause violence or verbal threaten another tenant with violence.

It seems to me that much of the cities SRO Policy is not being enforced. For instance: I believe it is the policy of most SRO's to not allow outsiders to conduct door to door solicitation in the building. However, if those outsiders happen to be "missionaries" with little goodie bags filled with stale ham and cheese sandwiches the front desk clerks tend to ignore this rule and let them go on in. It has come to my attention and I have personally witnessed many of these so called "missionaries" from either CitiTeam or YWAM (Youth With a Mission) express hostile negative attitudes towards Catholics, and Homosexuals. When they came to The Rose I politely asked them to please leave their food offering in the community room rather than go door to door. They refused stating "this isn't about free food. It's about having contact with people". Then they abruptly turned around and took their food to the next SRO. This incident demonstrates to me that they are only using the food as a way to gain access to the SRO's. Once inside the Tenants rooms the missionaries encourage the tenants to come to either YWAM or CitiTeam services. I have attended services at CitiTeam and YWAM. I can tell you from first hand experience that the people there are not friendly to either Catholics or Homosexuals. At YWAM I personally witnessed a homeless man being told that his rosary would be thrown into the garbage if he didn't put it away. Several gay men were told that they would burn in hell unless they allowed Jesus to make them straight. They

were offered to stay in a six month in-patient treatment facility. One man actually went there and paid \$3,000 out of his own pocket. He reported to me that the longer he stayed there the more suicidal he felt. When I contacted YWAM about this they refused to give the man a refund of his money.

This is NOT the type of program that I think SRO Tenants should be exposed to. As a member of the SRO Task Force I will see to it that the no solicitation policy is enforced. I will also see to it that all violent incidents are addressed appropriately.

Board Qualifications:

The SRO Task Force consists of a total of fourteen members, nine of whom are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors appoints nine voting members of the Task Force: two SRO tenant; two private SRO owners/operators; one non-profit SRO operator/owner; and one representative from each of the four SRO Collaboratives (Mission SRO Collaborative, Central City SRO Collaborative, Chinatown SRO Collaborative, and Families SRO Collaborative).

In addition to the above nine members, four voting members shall be appointed to the Task Force by the heads of each of the following San Francisco departments/agencies: The Director of the Human Services Agency will appoint one representative, the Director of the Department of Building Inspection will appoint one representative, the City Attorney will appoint one representative from the Code Enforcement Task Force, and the Director of the Department of Public Health will appoint one representative from Housing and Urban Health and one representative from Environmental Health. Also, the Director of the Department of Public Health will appoint one non-voting (except in the case of a tie vote) Task Force Chair.

The SRO Task Force shall monitor and make policy recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and annually produce a comprehensive report. The SRO Task Force will adopt and assist in the implementation of the following two goals:

A. Goal 1: San Francisco SRO Hotels are safe, accessible, stable, and 'just' places to live in. 1. Identify and provide training, consultation and direct services furthering this goal.

- 2. Develop and advocate legislation, regulations, policies and/or procedures furthering this goal.
- 3. Monitor compliance with relevant laws, regulations, policies and/or procedures.
- B. Goal 2: Affordable, healthy, and appropriate housing options are available in San Francisco so that extremely low-income families do not have to raise their children in SRO Hotels.
- 1. Advocate strategies to move families out of SROs and into permanent housing.
- 2. Advocate goals for assuring San Francisco housing and supportive housing units are affordable to 0-25% medium income families will be advocated for.
- 3. Advocate strategies to prevent families from losing their housing.
- 4. Review San Francisco Planning Code, Administrative Code, and other pertinent City Ordinances and recommend amendments necessary to implement Goal 2.

Term of Office: Members of the SRO Task Force shall be appointed for a term of three years. In the event a vacancy occurs, the Board of Supervisors shall appoint a successor to complete the remainder of that term.

Reports: The SRO Task Force shall monitor and make policy recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and annually produce a comprehensive report.

Sunset Date: The SRO Task Force shall sunset on December 31, 2012.
