

## LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code - Form 700 (Statement of Economic Interests) Filing Requirements - Sheriff's Department Oversight Board and Office of Inspector General]

**Ordinance amending the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code to update the Conflict of Interest Code's Form 700 (Statement of Economic Interests) filing requirements, and Sunshine and Ethics training requirements, by adding members of the Sheriff's Department Oversight Board and the Inspector General in the Sheriff's Department Office of Inspector General.**

### Existing Law

Existing law lists those Board and Commission members that must file Form 700 Statements of Economic Interests, Sunshine Ordinance Declarations, and Certificates of Ethics Training with the Ethics Commission. In addition, existing law lists the City department heads that must file their Form 700 Statements of Economic Interests, Sunshine Ordinance Declarations, and Certificates of Ethics Training with the Ethics Commission. Finally, existing law defines the disclosure categories for designated positions.

### Amendments to Current Law

This proposed ordinance adds the members of the Sheriff's Department Oversight Board and the Inspector General in the Sheriff's Department Office of Inspector General to the list of City officials required to file Form 700 Statements of Economic Interests, Sunshine Ordinance Declarations, and Certificates of Ethics Training with the Ethics Commission, and defines the disclosure category for each as Disclosure Category 1.

### Background Information

Proposition D, approved by the voters in November 2020, established the Sheriff's Department Oversight Board and the Sheriff's Department Office of Inspector General, headed by the Inspector General.
