Charles Siron, seat 1, succeeding himself, term expired, must be a SRO tenant, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending December 31, 2012.

Suresh Patel, seat 2, succeeding himself, term expired, must be a private SRO owner/operator, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending December 31, 2012.

Bruce Burge (residency requirement waived), seat 3, succeeding Dipak Patel, term expired, must be a private SRO owner/operator, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending December 31, 2012.

Seth Katzman, seat 4, succeeding himself, term expired, must be a non-profit SRO operator/owner, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending December 31, 2012.

Jorge Portillo, seat 5, succeeding himself, term expired, must be a representative of the Mission SRO Collaborative, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending December 31, 2012.

Jeff Buckley, seat 6, succeeding himself, term expired, must be a representative of the Central City SRO Collaborative, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending December 31, 2012.

- 3. The SRO Task Force has attempted to fill the position, for which Bruce Burge was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Bruce Burge is qualified to serve on the SRO Task Force.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the SRO Task Force at this time; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Bruce Burge, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to

boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
