15	WHEREAS, The applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of
16	California to carry out the Project; now, therefore, be it
17	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
18	approves the filing of an application for the Mission Creek Park Corridor and Community
19	Gardens; and, be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant
21	understands the assurances and certification in the application; and, be it
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant or title
23	holder will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project consistent with the land
24	tenure requirements; or will secure the resources to do so; and, be it
25	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that it will comply with
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the provisions of Section 1771.8 of the State Labor Code regarding payment of prevailing
wages on Projects awarded Proposition 50 Funds; and, be it

- FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that, if applicable, the 3 project will comply with any laws and regulations including, but not limited to, legal 4 requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, 5 environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits 6 will have been obtained; and, be it 7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant will work 8 towards the Governor's State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the 9 economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and safety as included in 10 Government Code Section 65041.1; and, be it 11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors appoints the Director of the 12 Office of Economic and Workforce Development, or designee, as agent to conduct all 13 negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, 14 agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the 15 aforementioned project(s). 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23
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
