"Individual or Nonprofit Organization" means <u>(a)</u> any person renting the County Fair Building or Botanical Garden in his or her individual capacity for private use, or <u>(b)</u> any entity qualifying for tax-exempt status under 26 U.S.C. \$ 501(c)(3), <u>engaged in community or social activities in which there are no monetary transactions (admission charge, donation, ticket sales, or product sales) during or in connection with the activity, or <u>(c)</u> any garden club or flower society using the County Fair Building or Botanical Garden for fundraising activities.</u>
 - (b) County Fair Building Facility Rental Fees. All spaces must be rented for a minimum of two hours.
