LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Recreation and Park Department – Botanical Garden Non-Resident Fees.]

Ordinance amending the San Francisco Park Code, Article 12, by amending Section 12.46, to establish admission fees to the Botanical Garden for non-San Francisco residents, and making environmental findings.

Existing Law

Currently, there are no admission fees for entrance to the Arboretum.

Amendments to Current Law

Non-San Francisco residents will be charged the following fees for entrance to the Arboretum:

Age/Category	Non S.F. Residents
Adults	\$7.00
Youth 1217 and Seniors 65 and over	\$5.00
Children 5—11	\$2.00
Children 4 and under	No charge
Families (2 adults and all children under 17 years residing in the same household)	\$15.00

In the event the Department receives new tax revenue in future years it shall rescind the nonresident fee for entrance to the Botanical Gardens.

With its budget submission for Fiscal Year 2011-12, the Department shall report to the Budget Finance Committee on its collection of the non-resident fee for entrance to the Botanical Gardens.

<u>The non-resident fee for the Botanical Gardens shall sunset at the end of Fiscal Year 2010-</u> <u>11.</u>
