**SUBJECT: Retroactive - California Department of Parks and Recreation  
900 Innes Boatyard Park - \$8,500,000**

The San Francisco Recreation and Park Department (RPD) has applied for and been awarded a Proposition 68 Statewide Park Grant in the amount of \$8,500,000 from the California State Parks and Recreation Department (DPR).

The retroactive actions that pertain to this grant are due to DPR's policy to back date their "Grant Performance Period" and "Grant Contract Period" to the date that grant funding is appropriated to the DPR.

The Grant Performance Period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2024. Project costs can be incurred and recover cost incurred during this period. The Grant Contract Period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2048 is the period in which park improvements funded by the grant must be operated and maintained for public use by the City. These contract obligations were initiated prior to the grant application or award period that occurred in 2020.

At this time, no grant funding has been expended.
