10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	
12	Section 1. Article 53 of the Police Code is hereby amended to remove Section 5312,
13	as follows:
14	
15	SEC. 5312. SUNSET DATE.
16	This Article 53 shall expire by operation of law 60 days after the County Health Officer amena
17	or terminates the Stay Safer At Home Order or any subsequent order regulating restaurants so that
18	restaurants may allow the number of patrons present in the indoor space of the restaurant to resume a
19	100% of the restaurant's maximum occupancy, provided that no subsequent order is issued to restrict
20	restaurant occupancy below 100% capacity during that 60-day window. Upon expiration, the City
21	Attorney shall cause this Article to be removed from the Police Code.
22	
23	Section 2. Effective Date; Retroactivity.
24	(a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment
25	occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or

1	does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors
2	overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
3	(b) The Board of Supervisors intends that Sections 5300-5311 of Article 53 of the
4	Police Code shall continue in full force and effect without interruption, notwithstanding the
5	County Health Officer's amendment or termination of the Stay Safer At Home Order or any
6	subsequent order regulating restaurants such that restaurants may allow the number of
7	patrons present in the indoor space of the restaurant to resume at 100% of the restaurant's
8	maximum capacity. Accordingly, the amendment made in this ordinance to remove Section
9	5312 from the Police Code shall be retroactive to the sunset date specified therein, thus
10	assuring that the other sections of Article 53 remain in effect, without interruption.
