





#### ANNOUNCEMENTS: ROUND 2 OF CA SMALL BUSINESS COVID-19 RELIEF **GRANT - OPEN NOW**

Yesterday, the State's Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program opened for Round 2 applications. This round will close February 8 at 6PM. Administered by the CA Office of Small Business Advocate and Lendistry, a tech-enabled community lender, the program offers \$5,000 to \$25,000 grants to eligible small businesses and nonprofits. Note: any Round 1 applicants that were not awarded but are eligible, will be automatically considered for the Round 2; you do not need to reapply. Resources to apply, include: application tips, webinars, ondemand videos (in multiple languages), application guides, and FAQs.
