## Direct Grants (GoBiz 2)

Purpose: To advance economic justice for populations and communities impacted by cannabis prohibition by supporting equity applicants and licensees with their start up and ongoing costs.

► <u>Term</u>: April 15, 2021 - October 31, 2022

Award: \$2,055,841.43

#### GoBiz 1: Cannabis Oversight Committee Recs\*

- ► Eligible grantees determined by a set point in time (10.14.20)
- Prioritization:
  - 1. 100% owners
  - 2. At least 51% owners
  - 3. At least 40% owners
- Allocated funds: (a) up to \$100K for 100% owners that moved past Planning; and (b) rest of funds split equally across others (~\$48K)
- Technical Assistance be made available and prioritized
