Attached, please find an original and two single-sided, black and white copies of a proposed resolution for Board of Supervisors approval that would adopt the San Francisco Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) FY2021-2022 Annual Update.

The Mental Health Services Act was passed in 2004 through a ballot initiative (Proposition 63) and provided funding to support new and expanded county mental health programs. San Francisco's MHSA FY2021-2022 Annual Update provides FY2019-2020 outcomes and implementation updates for FY2021-2022. This report is an update to the San Francisco Board of Supervisor's approved FY2020-2023 Three Year Program and Expenditure Plan. The MHSA FY2021-2022 Annual Update was developed with community and stakeholder input, posted for 30-day public comment, and heard at a Public Hearing at the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission, as required by the State to access MHSA funding. State legislation AB-1467 (2011-2012) also requires adoption of the MHSA Annual Update by the County Board of Supervisors prior to submission to the State Mental Health Services and Oversight Accountability Commission.
