

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - United States Homeland Security - California Office
2 of Emergency Services - Bay Area Urban Areas Security Initiative - \$33,012,500]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Emergency Management, on**
4 **behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, as the fiscal agent for the Bay Area**
5 **Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI), to accept and expend an increase to Fiscal Year**
6 **(FY) 2020 UASI grant funds in the amount of \$1,012,500 for a total of \$33,012,500 from**
7 **the U.S. Department of Homeland Security through the California Office of Emergency**
8 **Services, for the period of September 1, 2020, through May 31, 2023.**

10 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Homeland Security ("DHS"), has
11 several Homeland Security Grant Programs, including the Urban Areas Security Initiative
12 ("UASI") grant; and

13 WHEREAS, The UASI grant addresses the unique planning, equipment, training, and
14 exercise needs of high-threat, high-density Urban Areas, and assists those areas in building
15 an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover
16 from threats and acts of terrorism; and

17 WHEREAS, DHS distributes UASI grant funds to recipient jurisdictions in California
18 through the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES); and

19 WHEREAS, The Bay Area UASI Program includes the twelve contiguous Bay Area
20 counties and other governmental entities within those counties, and is governed by an
21 Approval Authority representing the largest cities and counties; and

22 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco serves as the fiscal agent for the
23 Bay Area UASI program, and disburses funds to jurisdictions in the Bay Area pursuant to the
24 direction of the UASI Approval Authority; and

1 WHEREAS, In FY2020-21, the adopted budget for the FY2020 UASI grant award was
2 \$32,000,000; and

3 WHEREAS, The final amount allocated to the Bay Area UASI in FY2020 is
4 \$33,012,500, which is an increase of \$1,012,500 over the anticipated amount; and

5 WHEREAS, San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 10.170.1 requires that an
6 increase in grant awards above \$50,000 be approved by the Board of Supervisors; and

7 WHEREAS, The Bay Area UASI must expend UASI funds by May 31, 2023; and

8 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary
9 Ordinance; and

10 WHEREAS, The grant does not provide for indirect costs; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes DEM, on behalf of the
12 City and County of San Francisco, to accept and expend the FY2020 UASI grant increase in
13 the amount of \$1,012,500, for a total of \$33,012,500; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board authorizes the DEM Executive Director, or the
15 Director's designee, to furnish whatever additional information or assurances that DHS or Cal
16 OES may request in connection with this grant, to execute any and all agreements or other
17 documents, and to take any other steps necessary to accept, distribute and expend the grant
18 funds; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the grant does not include any provisions for indirect
20 costs, and indirect costs are hereby waived.
