[Professional Services Agreement Amendment - Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC - Community Choice Aggregation Program - Not to Exceed \$18,769,225]

Resolution authorizing the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to execute Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. CS-247[R], Customer and Administrative Services for Community Choice Aggregation Program with Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC, for continued support of CleanPowerSF; and authorize the General Manager of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to execute this amendment, increasing the agreement amount by \$13,169,225 for a total not to exceed agreement amount of \$18,769,225 and to extend the term of the agreement up to three years, for a total term of November 1, 2015, through October 13, 2021, with a three-year option to extend.

WHEREAS, CleanPowerSF is San Francisco's Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) program offering cost-effective, cleaner energy to homes and businesses within the City; and

WHEREAS, On August 11, 2015, per Resolution No. 15-0175, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) awarded Agreement No. CS-247[R], Customer and Administrative Services for the CCA program, and authorized the General Manager of the SFPUC to negotiate and execute a professional services agreement in the amount of \$5,600,000 and with a term of three years, concluding on October 31, 2018, with Noble Americas Energy Solutions LLC, to provide meter data management, billing, and customer care services for CleanPowerSF; and

WHEREAS, Agreement No. CS-247[R] provided that the City will have the option to extend the contract for three years at the City's sole and absolute discretion; and

WHEREAS, On January 24, 2017, the SFPUC approved the assignment assumption of Agreement No. CS-247[R] from Noble Americas Energy Solutions LLC to Calpine Energy Solutions LLC (hereinafter "Calpine"); and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. CS-247[R] will extend Customer and Administrative Services provided by Calpine to the CleanPowerSF Program for a duration of three years, will result in \$2.2 million in savings over the next three years, and includes modifications to facilitate SFPUC's goal of transitioning CleanPowerSF call center operations in-house during the term of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, Calpine is currently performing services that are needed to continue providing meter data management, billing, and customer care services for CleanPowerSF; and

WHEREAS, The project team has concluded that Calpine is the only consultant that could readily perform these services without causing severe disruption to the continued operation of the program; moreover, background resources required to complete these services would be lost if the City was required to competitively procure the contract again; and

WHEREAS, Funds for this agreement are available from CleanPowerSF revenues; and

WHEREAS, On May 22, 2018, by its Resolution No. 18-0090, the SFPUC approved Amendment No. 1 to the Customer and Administrative Services Agreement No. CS-247[R], with Calpine to provide continued meter data management, billing, and customer care services for CleanPowerSF; and authorized the General Manager to

execute this amendment, increasing the amount of the agreement by \$13,169,225 for a total not-to-exceed agreement amount of \$18,769,225 and with a time extension of three (3) years for a total contract duration of six (6) years, subject to Board of Supervisors Approval pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 includes an option to extend the contract for a second and final time for a duration not-to-exceed three (3) years to October 31, 2024, which would require Board of Supervisors approval; and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves and authorizes the General Manager of the SFPUC to execute Amendment No. 1 to Customer and Administrative Services for Community Choice Aggregation Program Agreement No. CS-247[R], increasing the amount of the agreement by \$13,169,225 for a total not-to-exceed agreement amount of \$18,769,225 and with a time extension of three (3) years for a total contract duration of six (6) years, in substantially the form on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. 180560 and in such final form as approved by the General Manager and the City Attorney; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of Amendment No. 1 being fully executed by all parties the SFPUC shall provide the final contract to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
