

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - U.S. Department of Justice - Justice Reinvestment
2 Initiative - Amendment to Annual Salary Ordinance - FYs 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 -
3 \$1,000,000]

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4 **Ordinance retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and**
5 **expend a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice to fund**
6 **the Justice Reinvestment Initiative; and amending Ordinance No. 166-20 (Annual Salary**
7 **Ordinance File No. 200568 for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2020-2021 and 2021-2022) to provide**
8 **for the addition of two grant funded Class 8133 Victim/Witness Investigator III positions**
9 **(FTE 2.0) in the Office of the District Attorney for the period of October 1, 2020, through**
10 **September 30, 2023.**

15 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

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17 **Section 1. Findings.**

18 (a) The San Francisco District Attorney (“District Attorney”) was awarded \$1,000,000
19 by the U.S. Department of Justice to support the District Attorney’s Justice Reinvestment
20 Initiative, and was notified of the award via e-mail in November 2020 but not able to officially
21 accept it until March 2021.

22 (b) The award period is from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2023.

23 (c) The grant does not include any provision for indirect costs.

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25 **Section 2. Authorization to accept and expend grant funds.**

1 (a) The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney to
2 accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, U.S. Department of
3 Justice grant funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the Justice Reinvestment Initiative, which
4 aims to develop and implement innovative and research-based responses that address a
5 range of criminal justice system problems through the following strategies and activities: (1)
6 creation of the Young Adult Justice Initiative Workgroup whose activities will include the
7 development of a Young Adult Action Plan examination of the justice continuum through the
8 Sequential Intercept Model - including pre-adjudication and post-release; and (2)
9 subsequently expanding services and alternative approaches to address young people in
10 contact with San Francisco's justice system.

11 (b) The District Attorney proposes to maximize use of available grant
12 funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget, and
13 indirect costs are hereby waived.

14 (c) The total personnel budget for the two (2) new positions (2.0 FTE) is \$687,793
15 of the total grant award of \$1,000,000 for the term October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2023.
16 The balance of the grant award is allocated to pay for \$2,810 in technological supplies, \$2,997
17 in printing costs, and \$306,400 in contractual services.

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19 **Section 3. Grant funded positions: Amendment to Fiscal Years 2020-2021, 2021-2022**
20 **Annual Salary Ordinance.**

21 The hereinafter designated sections and items of Ordinance No. 166-20 (Annual Salary
22 Ordinance File No. 200568 for FYs 2020-2021 and 2021-2022) are hereby amended so that
23 the same shall read as follows:
