

1 [Settlement of Lawsuit - Stephanie Brunton - City to Receive \$40,000 from Walsh
2 Construction Company]

3 **Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Stephanie Brunton against the**
4 **City and County of San Francisco by payment of \$40,000 to the City by Walsh**
5 **Construction Company; the lawsuit was filed on April 29, 2019, in San Francisco**
6 **Superior Court, Case No. CGC-19-575558; entitled Stephanie Brunton v. City and**
7 **County of San Francisco, et al; the underlying lawsuit involves alleged personal injury**
8 **suffered as a result of an alleged dangerous condition on public property; other**
9 **material terms of the settlement are that the City and County of San Francisco will**
10 **dismiss its Cross-Complaint for indemnity and contribution against Walsh**
11 **Construction Company.**

13 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
15 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Stephanie Brunton v. City and County
16 of San Francisco, et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-19-575558 by the
17 payment of \$40,000 by Walsh Construction Company to the City. The lawsuit involves
18 alleged personal injury suffered as a result of an alleged dangerous condition on public
19 property.

20 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on April
21 29, 2019, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiff: Stephanie Brunton;
22 Defendant and Cross-Complainant: City and County of San Francisco; and Cross-Defendant
23 Walsh Construction Company.
