



#### **Program Monitoring**

- Department did not have documented policies defining program monitoring
- Review showed widespread inconsistencies

#### **Staffing & Vacancies**

2017-18	114.67	17	14.8%
2018-19	121.92	17	13.9%
2019-20	138.75	36	25.9%

#### Staffing & Vacancies: Updated

	Authorized Positions	Vacant Positions	Vacancy Rate
As of June 30, 2021	156.97	14	8.9%
As of July 1, 2021	192.97	34	17.6%

#### **ONE System Deficiencies**

- Primary data system to track clients and services
- Does not track available housing units, forcing manual workaround
- Example of inefficiency: December 2019 backlog of 200 available units

#### No Formal Oversight

- Local Homeless Coordinating Board does not have oversight over Department policies and operations
- Major decisions primarily made by Department officials and Mayor's Office.
- Working Group was created in 2019 to address stakeholder concerns regarding lack of oversight
  - This group's role should be expended to ensure sufficient feedback and transparency
