

FY22 & FY23 Budget Priorities



SFPL Budget Overview

- FY22: \$171.2M
 - $\circ~$ Following FY21 cuts of \$24.1M and FY22 cuts of \$12.1M from last cycle
 - \circ \$13.7M more than FY22 adopted budget
- FY23: \$172.3M
- Financial empowerment approach to revenues
 - Continuing with fine free SFPL
 - Seeking forgiveness of uncollectible debts
 - \circ $\,$ Free printing and copying





SFPL – Organizational Excellence



- Reduce bias and pursue a more racially just organization through training (Racial Equity Action Plan implementation) and personnel (new DEI position)
- Implementation and maintenance of recent investments (RFID, TBS, POSS, AMHS)
- Continued transparency and clean documentation for Friends and for Commission, including compliance with Executive Directive 20-02 and Controller recommendations

SFPL – Rebuilding for Resilience



- Facilities investments for state of good repair, safe and healthy workplaces, and climate resilience
- Mission Branch Renovation
- Chinatown Branch Renovation
- Ocean View Branch New Construction
- Investments in cultural sector grants and financial empowerment through work orders

SFPL – Impact-Driven Innovation



- Book vending machine pilots at Dogpatch and Hunters View (FY22) and Treasure Island (FY23)
- Youth Engaged in Library Leadership (YELL) expansion and connection to YouthWorks
- Scholars at Home investment in low-income families
- Outreach and engagement with immigrant communities proximate to the Main
