What is a Privately Manufactured Firearm

Privately manufactured firearms (PMF), also commonly known as "ghost gun" or "80% firearm," are firearms that have been made from unfinished frames/receivers and that are absent manufacturer's marks of identification.

In essence, PMFs are assembled with a variety of readily available parts, which are not subject to state or federal regulation, thereby circumventing record keeping, serialization, and background laws.





Dangers of PMFs

PMF parts/components are unregulated


- Allows for circumvention of background checks, cooling off period, record keeping
- PMFs make firearms accessible to prohibited persons (criminal record, court orders, mental illness)
- Lack of record keeping makes LE investigations more difficult
- Illegal purchase simplified
 - No need for straw purchase or travel to source states

Safety Factors

- Not made to proper quality control standards
- Prone to malfunction/unintended discharge
