1. What have the overall trends in the tech start-up industry over the last 5 years, including the number of new start-ups that opened in San Francisco, how many start-ups have moved out of San Francisco and where they moved operations, number of jobs created by the start-up industry, and number of San Francisco residents employed by SF-based start-ups? How do these trends compare with other cities?
2. What is the overall status and forecast of the technology sector in San Francisco more broadly, including employment, revenue, growth, closures, and movement of operations?
3. How has the COVID economic crisis and remote work impacted the tech sector and what are the forecasts for long-term impact?
4. What efforts are our city government currently taking or considering to support the technology sector and startups specifically?
5. What are the impacts of our city's policies on the ability of new tech start-ups to open in San Francisco? How do our policies compare to other Bay Area cities and cities in other States?
